#### Taylor Park #10-1735

New/Improved Park Amenities: Playground, tennis courts with lighting, wetland area with bridge, park shelter, looped path system and interpretive signage. **Grant Awarded:** February 2010 **Project Completed:** March 2012

#### Mills Park #11-1729

New/Improved Park Amenities: Looped path system, children's discovery play area & labyrinth, additional park entrances, perimeter fence restoration and interpretive signage. **Grant Awarded:** May 2011 **Project Completed:** June 2012 **Grant Amount:** \$400,000 **Total Project Cost:** \$873,766

#### Scoville Park PARC #11-32
