The PDOP Ice Show is the annual highlight of our Learn to Skate Academy! This event showcases the accomplishments of all our participants: beginner through advanced skaters, adults, and hockey skaters. No skater is too young, old, or inexperienced to participate. Join the Fun in 2019!

All participants must be registered for the Park District of Oak Park Skate Academy Session 3 (January-February 2019) in order to participate. Since there are no skills classes during the month of March due to show rehearsal, show participation is a great way for skaters to stay current with their skills! Skate Academy skills classes resume in April after the show.

Registration info: Please note that registration forms can only be accepted in-person at RCRC (415 Lake St). Forms must be completely filled out (front and back). Payments must accompany registration forms.

- * Save \$15 by registering early! **Early registration is due Saturday, January 12 by 3pm.**
- * **Registration closes on Thursday, January 31 by 3pm.** *We cannot accept any registrations after this time because of the lead time needed to order costumes.*
- * Please use a separate registration form for each skater if you have more than one skater in your household. A skater can have both their group and specialty numbers on one form. There are additional forms for feature skaters.
- * Show Registration: To register for a number, you must be registered for the corresponding classes in the Session 3 (January-February 2019). Even though a skater may move up a level for spring classes, we encourage showcasing established skills since skaters will be linking their skating skills with choreography and timing.
- * Specialty Registration: to register for a specialty number you must be registered for the corresponding classes in Session 3 (January-February 2019).
- * Registration for both group and specialty numbers will not be accepted if you are not registered for class.

Rehearsals:

Rehearsal schedule will be announced as soon as possible. Attendance at all rehearsals is mandatory. There is very little time for skaters to learn their numbers and it's very important they feel confident! Each group will have 3-4 rehearsals.

Costumes:

While we try our best to fit each skater, costumes are not custom-made. There is a range of measurements for each size and you may need to make minor alterations to your costume. Alterations are your responsibility and can be done at most dry cleaners. Tights are not provided with the costumes; however, they will be available for purchase at the Skate Rental counter. Please note that you may be charged \$5 for exchanging costume sizes.



- Costumes are ordered based on the skater's largest measurement. Costumes are not custom-made; please expect to make minor adjustments. Alterations are your responsibility.
- Go completely around the body for all measurements. Please measure in inches with a flexible measuring tape.
- Measure comfortably around the child – not too tight, not too loose.
- Leotard sizing costume available (ask Cathy Brown to try on)
